# Criteria and Procedures

Institute of Real Estate Management, Western Washington Chapter 27

## **PURPOSE**

The purpose of the scholarship program is to provide deserving individuals with financial needs the opportunity to attend IREM's membership qualification courses. The scholarship is available only for courses held in the Western Washington area. The scholarship is awarded for a specific course, sponsored by either the local chapter or the national office.

## **ADMINISTRATION and AUTHORITY TO CONFER**

The administration of this program is conducted by the Scholarship Committee of Western Washington Chapter 27 of IREM, which has complete and final authority to confer or revoke scholarships, make other decisions pertaining to the use of funds in the scholarship program, and determine the specific courses recipients shall attend under this program. Applications are evaluated and scholarships are awarded as decided by the committee based on the availability of funds and eligibility of the applicants.

# **ELIGIBILITY**

To be eligible for scholarship an applicant must

- 1) Be a citizen of the United States or Canada;
- 2) Be of legal age;
- 3) Be currently employed in some aspect of the real estate field;
- 4) Complete the official application form and submit it with all of the following:
  - a) Two letters of recommendation submitted in an envelope marked "Confidential" and sealed by the reference.
  - b) In a letter from the employer, a clearly written statement of the company's educational reimbursement policy. If there is no formal written policy, an explanation must be provided of how individual requests from employees for financial assistance to attend educational programs are judged. The letter should also specify whether the employer is providing any financial assistance to the applicant, and if not, why not.
  - c) A personal letter from the applicant describing the applicant's career objectives and goals, including information that would be helpful to the Committee in considering need for scholarship assistance.

# **SELECTION CRITERIA**

Applicants who meet the eligibility requirement are reviewed according to the following criteria:

- 1. Service performance in the industry;
- 2. Commitment to real estate management as a career objective and probability of success in this career;
- 3. Character, as demonstrated by community service, leadership, etc;
- Financial need.

The recipient is not required to make a commitment toward gaining the Certified Property Manager (CPM®) or Accredited Resident Manager (ARM®) designation to qualify for the scholarship award. However, the committee would hope that every participant who intends to make a commitment to a career in property management would at some point in his or her career give careful consideration to gaining the CPM designation and becoming an active member in the Institute of Real Estate Management.

## **AMOUNT OF AWARDS**

The scholarship awards will be determined by the scholarship committee. The committee may award either a full or partial scholarship at its discretion. The scholarship award is to be used solely to cover the cost of the course tuition and will be paid directly to the course registrar.

## **APPLICATION DEADLINES**

The deadlines shall be 15 days before the beginning of the course the applicant desires to attend. Decision by the committee shall be 7 to 10 days prior to the beginning of the course.

#### HOLD HARMLESS AND COMMITMENT to PROPERTY MANAGEMENT EDUCATION

All applicant and recipients will agree to hold IREM, the scholarship committee, their employees, agents, officers, councilors and chapters harmless from any claims arising out of participation in or application of this program.

The scholarship award provides needs assistance to individuals pursing their professional education in the field of real estate management. To the degree possible, scholarship recipients are encouraged to acknowledge this assistance at some time in the future by making a contribution to the scholarship fund and becoming a committee volunteer.
